Presentation

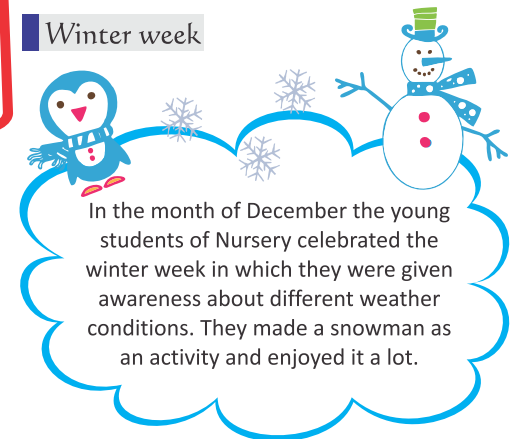
