### Global Hand Washing Day

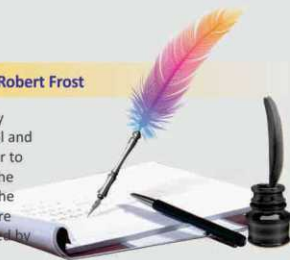

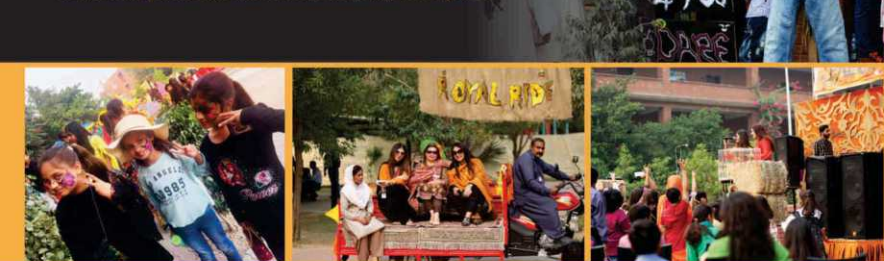


### Fall Fest
